## Definition For This File

## Counterexample: Fire Without Softness

The exception works when the intent is protection, clarity, or release rather than punishment. The test is simple: would the rite still feel right if nobody else suffered from it?

## The Less-Walked Path

The common road makes witchcraft aesthetic. The side road makes it domestic and operational: wash the cup, sort the herbs, write the letter, pay the bill, close the tab, speak the true sentence.

This path works because power often returns through ordinary arrangements. The altar is not separate from the sink, the calendar, or the invoice.
